If you do a Free promotion in a 90 day period, you can't do a Countdown Deal, and vice versa. In the 90 day enrollment period you are only given 5 free days per book. You don't have to use these, and if the time is almost up on your enrollment, and there are only two left, then two is what you get. You would then have to wait for it to restart back up with your new 90 day rollover enrollment if you continue in the program.

6. Discoverability and reader engagement: Kindle Unlimited can help authors and publishers increase their discoverability, as participating titles are included in the Kindle Unlimited catalog, making them easily accessible to subscribers. Additionally, reader engagement metrics, such as reviews and ratings, can contribute to the visibility of titles within the program.

7. Flexibility and control: Authors and publishers have control over their enrolled titles and can choose to enter or exit the KDP Select program as desired. This allows them to experiment with different publishing strategies and evaluate the performance of their titles in Kindle Unlimited.
